## Zentangled Greeting Cards



Great program for drop in events. Students of all ages. This program can be modified to fit any theme such as a school mascot. The Zentangle Method is a fun way to create beautiful images by drawing structured patterns called "tangles." Tangles are combinations of dots, lines, simple curves, S-curves, and orbs that make simple but beautiful art.

Zentangle expands creativity, improves focus and concentration, and promotes relaxation while having fun!

## Clay Animal Creatures



Making clay animals is a great way to turn any class room into an exciting craft day. With a little effort and a lot of imagination, you can turn your clay dough into art. Teaching Artist Kelly will help students use hand building techniques to create ceramic creatures of all colors, shapes, and sizes. Students will Develop a ceramic sculpture that is a combination of three distinctly different animals!

*Students will research different animals which, when combined together, make a unique creature. Use hand building techniques (coil, pinch, slab) to construct your hybrid creature within a 4" x 4" wide, 6" tall size framework.*
